The license shall automatically expire when either of these conditions ceases to exist.

Which Course is Right For You?

All new trainees must take **PSMA/NOF-101**. If you are certified but have only limited field experience, and need to brush up on the very basic concepts, PSMA/NOF-101 is the right choice to meet your beginner needs. Because PSMA/NOF-101 is for beginners, trainees are limited to two consecutive attendances. If you are certified and use or have used the Standards at times in the past, the **PSMA/NOF-102** is more appropriate. Detailed course outlines for the courses are available in the “Education > Training” section of PSMA’s website.

Please Note: The skills of reading and writing English are required prerequisites for training and for all candidates who will take the PSMA/NOF certification exam. PSMA/NOF-certified inspectors must be able to follow written instructions, record field measurements, write answers to questions and draw conclusions. Trainees must be able to complete the training and the exam without reading or writing assistance. Persons with disabilities should notify the PSMA Office in advance of the session, and reasonable accommodations will be made to assist in facilitating your participation.

Be Prepared! All trainees should bring materials to take notes. A calculator will be beneficial. If you have inspection tools such as probe rods, flashlight, mirror, tape measure and gloves, please bring them. Both 101 and 102 include a field trip to nearby onlot systems with hands-on application of inspection skills. The field activity on Day 2 operates rain or shine. Dress appropriately for field conditions; bring a change of shoes.

Drip Irrigation System Inspection Endorsement Course

Upon successful completion of this 1-day course, you will obtain a PSMA endorsement to inspect and sign reports for the inspection of American Manufacturing’s Perc-Rite® Drip Dispersal System. You will become familiar with all drip system components and their proper operation. After inspection of a Drip System, you will be able to evaluate and reach a conclusion about each component, as well as the entire system, to write and sign a certification report. You **must** be a current PSMA/NOF certified inspector to take this course. All classroom-based instruction. Worth 6 PSMA SR1 CEUs. *Space is limited.*

101 Basic Onlot Wastewater Treatment Systems Inspection Certification

This beginners course covers the PSMA/NOF Inspection Standards. Subjects covered include: system permitting and operations history, basic system components, the basics to locating systems, basics to recognizing problems, analysis of inspection results and evaluation report writing. Individuals who complete the course work and achieve a passing grade on the post-training exam become 101 certified. PSMA-NOF Inspection Standards can then be used under a limited license agreement.
