**Opening Session: PFAS in Land Applied Biosolids - Challenges & Management Options**

**Presenter:** Dr. Linda Lee, Purdue University





# CONTINUING EDUCATION

---

Continuing education credits are available for those attending the 2026 Onsite Wastewater Super Conference of Pennsylvania.

Upon checking-in at the Conference Registration Desk, you should have received an **“Attendance Documentation Form”** listing all the sessions you signed up for. If you are seeking PSMA, SEO, or other continuing education credits, you must have each session moderator stamp your Attendance Documentation Form to verify your attendance at that session.

At the conclusion of the Conference, please return the Attendance Documentation Form to the Registration Desk for processing. **Without returning this form we cannot report your continuing education credits.**

If you are attending one of the formal approved training courses, the course instructor will have a separate sign-in sheet in the classroom for you to document your attendance. For these courses only, use the sign-in sheets instead of the Attendance Documentation Form.

## **PSMA SRI Credits:**

Those PSMA-certified inspectors enrolled in the SRI Program can earn continuing education credits. PSMA/NOF 101 Basic, 102 Advanced, & 103 Experienced inspector certifications do not require continuing education credits -- only SRI certification. One PSMA SRI continuing education credit is awarded for each conference breakout session attended for a maximum of 8 credits. If you are taking a formal training course on Sunday, Monday, and or Tuesday, they are worth three SRI credits for a half day, six for a full day, or twelve for a 2-day course.

## **PA SEO Credits:**






